4. Programme summary:

As a part of the linkage with Vijaya Diagnostic Laboratory, near Bus stand, Anantapuramu, (located near the College) which handles around 30-40 clinical samples/ day, three students of have benefited from three day internship programme. The aim was to get the student acquainted with the day to day proceedings of a diagnostic lab like patient interaction, briefing the patient and preparing them for sample collection; Collection of various types of samples, storage and processing of the samples; biochemical and microbiological tests involving microscopic observation, kit based methods and automated methods.

The students were assisted by the laboratory technician and Sri A. Damodar, Laboratory in-charge. On completion of three day internship, the students were acquainted with - precautions taken during collection of clinical specimens, serum separation, kit methods for diagnosis of HIV, Dengue, Typhoid, Malaria, VDRL, HCV, HBV; Smear test for malaria. The students could observe the working of hematology analyzer. The students have submitted a report on "Collection,Storage And Processing Of Clinical Samples"
